Typically, truck cranes have 2 different cabs. One cab is for controlling the crane and the other is for driving the truck when the unit is in transport mode. These cranes are extremely useful for building locations where a crane is needed in numerous different locations for the duration of the build. This is because of the fact that the crane could be driven easily from one place to another. Cranes could also be transported to different construction locations on the road because they drive themselves, which eliminates the need for extra transport vehicles. Being able to travel on their own greatly reduces transport expenses at the end of the day. The truck crane however is not stable enough to handle all the major loads that a hydraulic crane could handle. Thus, to be able to fix this issue, outriggers could be extended from the deck. The outriggers use hydraulic pressure to be able to slightly lift the truck off of the ground, making it balanced and stable. Crawler cranes feature big tracks on the bottom of the crane. These huge tracks are like the ones seen on other construction machinery such as bulldozers and backhoes. The tracks allow the crane to move around a construction site successfully.
